## 2017 CAMPER PACKING LIST

All pieces of equipment and clothing must be marked with the camper's name.

BRING THIS LIST WITH YOU TO CAMP, and be sure to check this list when you are packing to go home.


### Camp Dress Code

All clothing and swimwear are to be modest and appropriate to an Orthodox Christian witness. Clothing cannot promote violence, alcohol, tobacco and drug use or display undesirable messages. The length of the shorts must be no shorter than to within one hand's width (approximately 4 inches) of the top of the knee. Pants will be worn at the waist. . . no saggin' or baggin'. Pajamas may not be worn as outerwear. Swimsuits should not be overly revealing. If you choose to dress inappropriately, you will be asked to change, be required to wear a camp-issued shirt, or be told you may not swim.

### Basic Gear

- Water Bottle-essential!**
- Sleeping Bag and/or Sheet and blanket
- Pillow
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Comb or Brush
- Soap & Shampoo
- 1 large Bath Towel
- Sunscreen**
- Beach towel
- Laundry Bag
- Flashlight
- Insect Repellent
- Medication: Complete instructions must be given to Camp Director

### Clothing

- Socks: at least 1 pair per day
- Underwear: 1 pair per day
- T-Shirts (**no inappropriate logos/artwork—straps at least 2 fingers wide**)
- Shorts (no shorter than mid-thigh)
- Jeans/ Khakis
- Swimsuits: BOYS - swimming trunks; GIRLS — modest 1-piece or full takini's ONLY (t-shirts over 2 piece not allowed);**
- Jacket/Sweater/ Sweatshirt
- Shoes: At least 1 pair of Sneakers & Dress Shoes
- Clothes for Monastery (see note) 

**Important:** Inappropriate clothes will NOT be allowed to be worn during camp. We will have a supply of generic "camp clothes."

If a camper does not bring appropriate clothing they will be required to wear items from the "camp clothes."

### Other

- Water Bottle (essential!)**
- Sun Cap or Hat
- Small Bible w/concordance
- Camera
- Small Notebook & Pen
- Small Icon
- Swimming goggles (none provided by camp)
- Reading Material

### Visit to Monastery

We celebrate the Divine Liturgy once during camp. We are very blessed that the Monastery of the Life-giving Spring next to camp allows us to celebrate it there. The Monastery does have a dress code. Campers need to bring appropriate clothes for the visit to the monastery. Even though it is in the morning, it does get hot. **Be sure clothes are light-weight fabrics.**  
Male: Dress Shirt, Nice Pants & Dress Shoes  
Female: Dress or Skirt, Blouse & Dress Shoes. (Dress/ Skirt to be at least knee length - shoulders must be covered: **NO tank tops, sleeveless shirts or spaghetti straps**)

### Things to leave at home

(if brought they will be confiscated and might not be returned)

- Tobacco Products
- Alcohol & Drugs
- Weapons including pocket knives, etc.
- Food
- iPods, TV's, Radios, CD/DVD players, E-readers
- Cell phones, Computer Games/DS, PSP, etc./
- Immodest or Inappropriate Clothing
- Valuables including jewelry and large amounts of cash
- Unchristian Bad attitudes
